

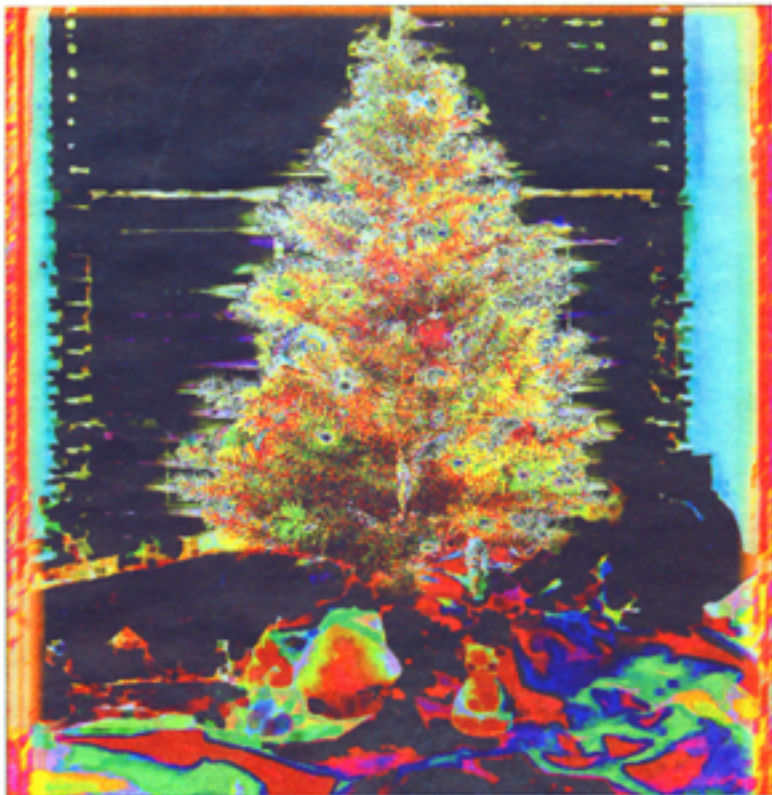

» **Clayton Galleries.**

4105 S MacDill Ave., Tampa, takes as its theme for the holiday show "Small Works." Owner Cathy Clayton asked 27 artists (including Bruce Marsh, Craig Rubadoux, Joyce Ely-Walker, Yoko Nogami, Robin Cody, Jeffrey Kronsoble and Dolores Coe) to create works measuring 24 inches or less, a perfect size to wrap and nestle under a tree. Media include oil, acrylic and watercolor paintings; sculpture; mobiles; mixed media on paper; and photography, including this manipulated digital photograph by Roberta Schofield. Hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Friday and 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday. The show continues through Jan. 22. Free. (813) 831-3753.
